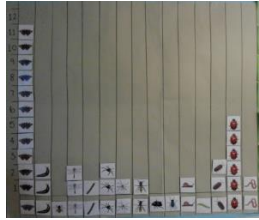

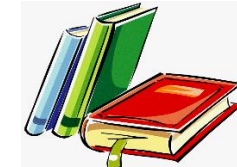
### Task 1 (Maths)

### Task 2 (Science)

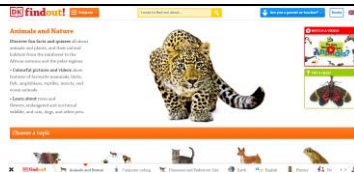
