Nursery

This week we have been focusing on celebrating Kings Charles III Coronation. We have been learning some facts about King Charles III and his family from fact sheets and sharing the story, The Colourful Coronation. We have enjoyed making flags, streamers and crowns. For funky fingers we have we have been developing our finger strength by decorating crowns and creating paper chains. Many thanks to all of you for your contributions to Food Bank Aid and our Nursery Coronation party. Your support and kindness is really appreciated. The children looked amazing in their Kings and Queens costumes. Reminder that we have PE on a Wednesday—please make sure your child is wearing socks (no tights) and has shoes with Velcro fastenings so that they can take them off and on independently. We are enjoying our music lesson on Thursdays. During the lesson we were introduced to the Coronation song, To the Sound of Trumpets, by Out of the Ark. We joined in with the song with lots of enthusiasm.

The children have been busy preparing for the King's Coronation. They enjoyed a special Coronation lunch and had a picnic to celebrate the occasion. In maths the children have been learning about doubling and in English we have continued with our book about the Savannah and also exploring different texts, fiction and non-fiction. Phonics lessons have continued, please help and support your children at home, by encouraging them to use their phonological awareness in their writing. Year 1

Year 1 have had a right royal week with us all preparing for the Coronation of King Charles III. We have learnt about King Charles, made crowns, made collages, coloured in posters... and some of us even dressed up as royalty, with the rest in a sea of red, white and blue! It all culminated in a Coronation picnic, with us all wearing our crowns as the Royal Houses of Maple and Chestnut. We have been learning about mass in maths, practising the terminology 'heavier than' 'lighter than'. In English, we predicted what we thought would happen in the story and got to see whether we were correct or not- the children have loved learning about the girl in 'Wild' by Emily Hughes. Year 2

Y2 enjoyed reading Rapunzel by Bethan Woollvin this week. The fairy tale is told with a twist. There is no handsome Prince to save Rapunzel! We think Rapunzel is smart to figure her own way out, defeating the witch, and going on to a successful witch-hunting career! It reminded us other stories we read this year such as How to Find Gold and The Secret of Black Rock. In maths, we are continuing with fractions. We still need to work on finding quarters and thirds of amounts. Please talk to your children about fractions at home, Food is a fantastic resource for fractions, you can use pasta pieces or dried beans then have your child sort them in to halves, quarters and thirds. Year 3/4 have been making preparations for our whole school King's Coronation Tea Party. We designed and created crowns in keeping with the theme Kings and Queens!
