Safeguarding: What Parents and Carers need to Know about iPads

When Apple unveiled the iPad in early 2010, they almost singlehandedly rewrote people's idea of what a portable computing device was capable of-and sparked a tablet revolution. There are several very respectable imitators on the market now, but iPad remains the standard bearer for tablet computers and routinely shifts upwards of 40 million units every year.

Their immense popularity has made iPad a familiar companion for children and young people: an auxiliary TV; an aid for schoolwork; and a blessing for long car journeys. That said, there are still some aspects of Apple's flagship tablet that parents and carers should bear in mind to help protect their children from online risks.

The guide attached this week highlights possible hazards including the risk of age-inappropriate content, physical damage to the device and potential screen addiction.
